

I have two important requests to share with you:



A Minute of Minutes ~ Secretary AJ Perea Reports

The Mile High Magicians Society (Ring #131/Assembly #37) hosted its first official meeting of 2024 at our new location at the HUB Stage in 40 West Arts District. The club thanks **Chad Wonder** for allowing us to use the space and for opening it up to local magicians.

The first order of business was our new president, **Dan Rodriguez**, going over the proposed updates to the constitution prior to voting. The next order of business was swearing in the new officers. **Mark Wiedhaas**, past National President for the Society of American Magicians, led the proceeding. He immediately presented a past president pin to **Jeff Jenson**. The elected candidates raised their right hands and swore to uphold the constitution and their duties to their respective offices. Once the ceremony was complete, all of the incoming officers took the stage.

The first act featured the comedic duo of **Jeff and Karen Wake**, returning sergeantsat-arms, performing a routine consisting of forty-two illusions. Many of these tricks can be found in magic kits and magic shops. This included the mirror box, squarecircle, and the linking rings.

Following that was **A.J. Perea**, the incoming secretary who performed a card trick. He brought up a spectator to have them select a card. He asked the spectator to spell out the name of their card with the deck, which called the card back.

Incoming treasurer, **Shane Cohen**, routine revealed a spectator's card in a unique manner. The spectator's card was revealed to be hidden in a jack-in-the-box. The monkey inside was holding the prediction.

Former secretary, **Glenn Proulx**, revealed a spectator's card based on their birthday. He then took three large playing cards representing two-dimensions and formed a temple. Inside the temple, Glenn produced three cubed dice representing threedimensions.

Another past National Society of American Magicians president and incoming president, **Dan Rodriguez**, held up a magic dartboard with numbers on it. The audience threw invisible darts at the board. On the back of the dartboard, Dan had correctly predicted the target.

Shawn Popp closed out the evening with his rendition of cards across. He had two spectators, ten cards each. While the cards were in their hands, three cards magically moved from one side of the room to the other.

Our first meeting of the year was filled with amazing illusions from our executive team. However, they have more surprises, illusions, guests, and opportunities during the coming year.
