

Get Ready... Get Set... It's SHOW TIME!










Call for Talent 2024 Public Show Auditions

Magic film festival and *"mini"* magic convention held at Theater of Dreams in Castle Rock on Saturday, August 17 was an amazing experience for the local magicians who attended the event. *The Amazing Lamont* documentary was shown followed by Q&A and a rare lecture featuring Lamont Ream himself (via Zoom). At the conclusion of his presentation, The Mile High Magicians Society presented Lamont with the prestigious **Dave Elstun Honorary Life Membership**.

Next-up was a teach-in and discussion with **Joe Givan** and **Shawn Popp** and performances by **Will Mannsz** and **Richard Kwesell**. The day concluded with the showing of *Lost in the Shuffle* documentary followed by Q&A with celebrity magician **Shawn Farquhar** and movie producer **Jon Ornoy** (via Zoom).

The Deans Magical Musings - Gene Gordon

Hello Fellow Mile High Magician Society Members!

I had promised to also include some magic in these columns. Here is a great little (yes, card trick) trick I have been doing for years:

"Liars Transpo"

Effect: A classic effect done with 'acting' as part of the method. A freely selected card is lost in the pack. The magician then finds 'the wrong card'... this wrong card magically changes/transposes with the actual selected card!

Bonus Effect: The card changes back, and the selection is found in the magician's pocket or wallet!

Sleights Needed: Classic force and/or glimpse, double lift, top change, top palm. Some acting... but not overacting.

Routine: Bring out the pack of cards and shuffle it, asking the spectator (Liz) if she's ever had her mind read. Say, "Today's the day then!" Move a known card into position for the Classic force where the force card is 'above' your little finger in the break. An easy way to get there is to do an "All-around square-up" and spot the bottom card. Then overhand shuffle this card to the center of the pack, holding a break below it as described above.

Force the card on Liz. (You say, "I don't like or do the Classic force.") Then do what I do if the force fails... and they end up picking any card. Have them return it to the pack and do the Le Paul automatic jog control. Once you have the break (on the card), do the classic center glimpse of the card. In either case (force or glimpse), you can now shuffle the deck freely. Do not control the card! This will kill the upcoming acting. The deck needs to be seen to be freely and genuinely shuffled.

Say to Liz, "Look deeply into my eyes..." Do your best Max Maven/Kreskin impression with your eyebrows. Say, "I think I've got it." Spread the deck, faces towards yourself. Now comes the acting and setting of the pack for the double lift in a moment. Look at Liz, look at the pack, up-jog any card somewhere around midway or so. Look at it again and shake your head no, then pull that card back flush. This sequence is very important to set up the spectators and what you are doing and going to do in a moment. Now say the selection is the 10 of Hearts. You want a contrasting card on the top of the pack. If the top card is a low-value black card, you're good to go! If not, simply move one (low-value black card) there while you continue your search for Liz's card. Assume you slipped the 2 of Spades to the top to contrast her 10 of Hearts.

Now spread through to her 10 of Hearts and let your face brighten up with a wry smile. Up-jog it as you say, "Yes, this

is the one," or something to that effect. Pull the 10 of Hearts out with your right hand and turn the deck face down in your left hand. Time for an "Ascanio in transit action" move. Say, "Hold out your hand." As you say this, set the 10 of Hearts back on top of the pack as you gesture with your right hand, palm up. As you do this, do a 'one-hand get' ready for a double lift with the left hand.

The right hand comes back to the pack, and you do the double lift (not turnover), showing the 2 of Spades. The card should come fully away from the pack. You say, "One card out of 52: the (name the card) 2 of Spades..." Add, "That is one of my favorite cards." Turn the card back down on the pack as you finish saying, "favorite cards." Look up at Liz in her eyes as you set the card (10 of Hearts) on her hand. Cut her off before she protests that the 2 of Spades is not her card. I say, "I can tell by your look of disappointment... This wasn't your card."

Say, "They say you should always stick with your first impressions." As you say this, while still looking at her, cut the pack. Now, you could do a pass, but after doing this effect for 30 years, the simple cut of the pack works best. It happens out of "frame" anyway. Now turn the pack faces towards yourself and spread until you come to the 2 of Spades. Pull it out of the spread (without showing it) and now "lie."

With your best bit of acting, say, "Was it a red card? Was it a heart? Was it the Ten of Hearts?" They will say yes! Look a bit crestfallen. Now comes an excellent, almost "sponge balls in the hands" moment.

Say, "But I am the magician (or magic guy)... all I have to do is wave my hand over the 10 of Hearts (really the 2 of Spades), and it becomes the 2 of Spades!" Flip the card over face up on the deck and then say, "That means the card in your hand is now the 10 of Hearts!" When they turn it over and it's their card... screams of "No way!" and other choice words can often be heard!

Bonus: The following is a fun and magic-filled addition to the "Liars Transpo."

As they are reacting to the effect above, move the card (2 of Spades in the example above) to the top of the facedown deck. Retrieve the 10 of Hearts from them. I say, "You know why this works? The 1970s. Back then, they had those mood rings that could change with your body temperature." As I say the above line, I look at them directly and top change the 10 of Hearts for the 2 of Spades and set the 2 of Spades back face down in their hand. I say, "This card is like those rings... It takes just a moment and changes back!" Gesture towards the card in their hand, implying they turn it over. As they turn it over and get another nice surprise that the card has changed again, they'll react. As they react, top palm the 10 of Hearts in your right hand. Then casually drop it off in your right pants pocket or load it into your wallet. Let a few beats of time go by and say, "The thing that gets me is how you ever got the 10 of Hearts as it's my lucky card and I always keep it in my..." Now produce the card from your pocket or wallet to cap off this little bonus section!

Comments: This routine (in a much simpler form) was first printed in the "Orville Meyer (1911-1992) Commemorative" issue of MUM magazine. A number of us Denver magicians included tricks in this issue of the magazine. Orville was a great magician and friend of mine.

Ask me to perform this for you next time I see you. Remember to practice this and have fun doing it!
