The Mile High Magicians Society held a showcase of some of Denver's professional close-up magicians. A few small close-up stages were set up around the room, so each performance would be intimate. Our performers Shawn Popp, Dennis Michael,

Gene C Gordon, Gerald Robinson, and Jude Griffin rotated around the room with their fifteen-minute show.

Jude Griffin pulled two kings from the deck that could track down any card. He then had a spectator select a card from the deck. Without fail, the two kings were able to appear on the top and bottom of the deck no matter how they were placed.

Gerald Robinson was able to connect important names with cards. He had a volunteer select a card. He then also had them select a name that was important to them. Gerald then pulled out a special deck with names written on them. He pulled a card out of the deck that matched the selected card and the selected name.

Dex performed a hilarious coin and card magic routine. A selected card traveled between the deck and his coat pocket several times. At one point, the entire deck moves to his pocket, minus the selected card. He also showed how coins can travel between his hands and a cup he keeps under his coat.

Gene Gordon performed card magic inspired by Dai Vernon. He was able to 'develop' a card that a spectator chooses similar to a Polaroid picture. He also switched the backs of the cards at will, changing the colors and the styles.

Each performer brought their style and humor to connect with the audience. We are fortunate that the Mile High City has amazing close-up magicians.

Magic Week


